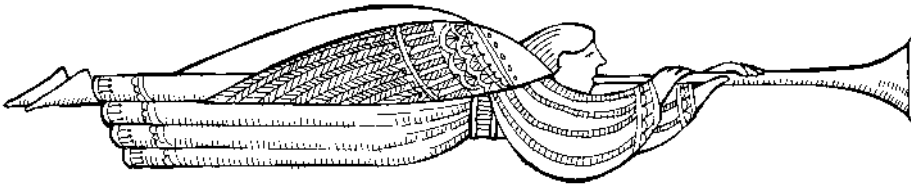
Committee Meetings begin this week. Deacons should have received their reminder last week. If you did not please contact the office.
