Just Coffee For Sale in Fellowship Hall before and after church each Sunday. The display is near the stained glass window. You may pay by cash or check & the proceeds benefit Café Justo. More information is at justcoffee.org. A note from Eileen explains why there is a short supply of coffee available. "It may be some time before Trinity receives additional shipments of Just Coffee to sell. That is because Café Justo had a number of challenges to their operations in 2025. The challenges included a supply shortage of coffee beans, pricing adjustments that were needed due to the increased cost of coffee beans and processing, and "a landscape of uncertainty around import/export requirements & tariffs." They are working with Frontera de Cristo to stabilize their operations in 2026 and are hoping to start processing coffee once the next coffee harvest is completed in February. They plan to raise prices somewhat, and the size of the coffee packages will be reduced from a 1 pound size to a $\frac{3}{4}$ pound size. We will keep current on what is happening and place an order for new coffee as soon as they are operational again."

Food Pantry Numbers In December 596 people in 279 households received 284 Food Bank Boxes through our Food Pantry with 45 return pantry visits. There were 402 Walk-ins - an average of 50/day.
