Just Coffee For Sale in Fellowship Hall before and after church each Sunday. The display is near the stained glass window. You may pay by cash or check & the proceeds benefit Café Justo. A note from Eileen explains why there is a short supply of coffee available. "It may be some time before Trinity receives additional shipments of Just Coffee to sell. That is because Café Justo had a number of challenges to their operations in 2025. They plan to raise prices somewhat, and the size of the coffee packages will be reduced from a 1 pound size to a $\frac{3}{4}$ pound size. We will keep current on their progress & place an order for new coffee as soon as they are operational again."

Mission Committee's February Special Offering

The Mission Committee is designating the Sister Jose' Women's Center (located at 1050 S. Park Avenue) as the organization to receive the February Mission special offering which will be collected in person on Sunday, February 22.

The offering also may be made online throughout the month of February at trinitytucson.org. The GIVE NOW button is at the bottom of the home page.

“Sister Jose' Women's Center is a Tucson-based 501c3 organization that exists to aid and transform the lives of women who are unhoused. Their low-barrier day center provides unaccompanied women who are unhoused with a stable and safe environment to recuperate from the daily struggle of homelessness and extreme poverty. The center was “built on the teachings and compassion of Sister Jose' Hobday, a Franciscan nun who dedicated her life to helping the poor... Sister Jose' believed that we should “live life with hands and hearts open, sharing, and serving others.”

The Sister Jose' Women's Center is a “low-barrier” shelter which means any woman who is unhoused is welcomed with open arms. Center Services include MEALS (3 meals a day, 6 days a week), LAUNDRY(Guests can clean their clothes and personal belongings), CLOTHING (donated clothing plus new underwear). SAFE SPACES (guests are met where they are and their beloved pets are included “All are treated with the respect and dignity they deserve.”)
