Food Pantry Numbers In May, 711 people in 297 families received 336 Temporary Emergency Food Boxes. There were 482 walk-ins averaging 60/day. There were 113 pantry visits (families who returned multiple times). We corrected for the number of people who came more than once. That was inflating the numbers. We gave out non-food items: socks, hygiene bags, whistles, lip balm, pet food, bandanas, and toilet paper.
